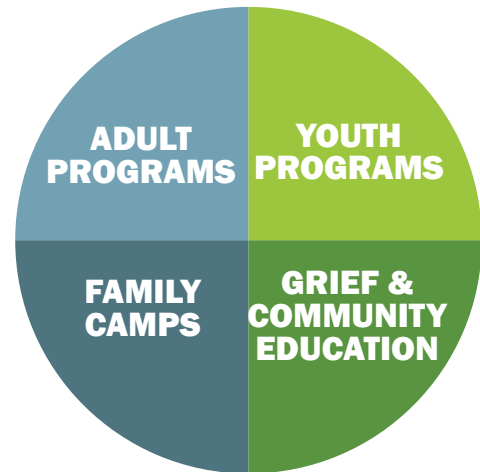

## HOW IS NEW HOPE FUNDED?

New Hope does not receive any federal, state or local government funding. New Hope is dependent on support from the communities we serve and the endless generosity and talents of over 100 volunteers. Our sources of revenue are annual fundraising events, private grants and, most importantly, pledges obtained during our annual Community Support Campaign. Each member of our Board of Directors, our staff, and donors like you assure the robust fulfillment of our mission.



## NEW HOPE'S FAMILY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Some of our programs carry very modest fees but it is our policy NOT to deny services because of any financial difficulty those fees may cause. Each year our Family Assistance Program enables us to faithfully fulfill that policy and provide scholarship funding to individuals and families who need it. These scholarships are provided from funds raised during our Community Support Campaign.

## HOW WILL THE COMMUNITY SUPPORT CAMPAIGN FUNDS BE USED?

As previously indicated, our important programs are dependent on the generosity of the communities we serve! Every penny of every dollar pledged during our Community Support Campaign will be used to:

- Support activities for which there is no off-setting revenue some support groups and family camp.
- Help fund the difference between the true cost of providing programs and, if any, minimal program fees associated with them.
- Provide funding to support the Family Assistance Program.
- Provide the resources necessary to build our capacity to serve the ever-growing need for more grief support programs.

## CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS AT WORK

Mortality rates for adults in their 40s & 50s in the past two decades have risen dramatically, making it more likely that younger children will experience the death of a parent, or a classmate's parent.
